We would like to use the G Suite from Google with the Students for their classes. **GSuite** is a free Web-based application in which documents, presentation slides and spreadsheets can be created, edited and stored online. Files can be accessed from any computer with an Internet connection and a full-featured Web browser. **Google Docs, Slides, Sheets, etc.** are compatible with most presentation software and word processor applications.” This makes it a very useful set of tools that can be used for individual classes or even group projects! The Google Suite is an important skill that the students will be able to use for high school and beyond! In setting up the Google classroom document files, we will also be setting up each student with a Gmail account for schoolwork. Please sign the permission slip below as we would like to introduce this skill to the students at the beginning of school year. (Even if your child has a gmail account, we will need to set up a separate BSS gmail.) Students will be instructed that this is a School account. Everything including chats when students collaborate, can be pulled up by the instructor and in keeping with our Catholic faith. Refer to our Technology Student Agreement.
