Savannah Deanery Policy on School Subsidies

At a meeting of the priests of the Savannah Deanery, which took place at the Benedictine Priory on January 6, 2015, the following policy was proposed and accepted unanimously by the Priests:

1. No parish which has a parish school will pay any subsidy to another Catholic school for a student whose family chooses not to attend their parish school, unless there is no room for that student in the parish school. At the discretion of the Pastor, a subsidy may be paid for a student to attend another Catholic school when there are special circumstances or needs.
2. Each Catholic school in the Savannah Deanery should have a three-tiered tuition schedule. There should be:
 - a.) An In-Parish Catholic Tuition
 - b.) An Out-of-Parish Catholic Tuition
 - c.) A Non-Catholic Tuition

The difference between the In-Parish Catholic Tuition and the Out-of-Parish Catholic Tuition will be \$1,000. This will also be the amount of subsidy paid on behalf of each student by a parish which has no Catholic School. Students will continue to qualify for parish subsidy based upon the criteria established by each individual parish.

This policy was proposed and drafted by a Committee of the Priests, in conjunction with the Principals of the Catholic Schools in the Savannah Deanery, which met on December 9, 2014 at Blessed Sacrament Parish. It was voted upon and approved by all the Priests of the Deanery at the January 6th meeting.
